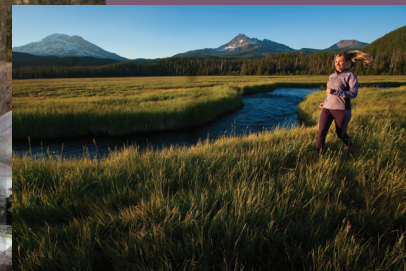

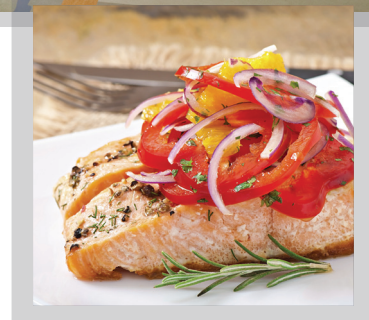
QUALITY CATERING
