New Business

- 1) Update on related instruction
 - a) The task force has broken up into smaller sub groups to address computation and communication
 - b) Human relations the best defined based on work done in 2010
 - c) Computation is pretty well defined
 - d) Communications group is determining what CTE programs need
 - e) Survey sent to CTE indicated a need for writing for the workplace, oral communication practice
 - i) This is challenging because no specific curriculum addresses this need
 - ii) Should courses be created to address the need?



- iii) Few instructors have the qualifications to teach both disciplines
- iv) Should oral communication be addressed in Human Relations speech courses
- v) Speech courses used to meet the requirement for Human Relations could not also be used for Communication requirement.
- f) Embedding related instruction in courses is still a consideration; however, it must be more than an assignment. It must be actual instruction of the material. The other concern is there faculty members that are qualified to teach all disciplines in one course.
- g) Goal is to have the committee work completed by mid-winter
