The program description for 5142 AAS refers to both AAS and CC leading to employment as a technician or middle manager. This was edited during the meeting to reflect only AAS preps towards technician and middle management.

2. SOC Department, Criminal Justice Discipline, Sara Henson

Context from Sara Henson: Originally PS 250 taught by someone with both CJ and political science background; upon review, they decided it fit better in CJ discipline. Searched other colleges and universities for equivalency and found a number of similar courses used to help with outcomes revision.

Discussion:

- Formerly taught under PS prefix but not equivalent to this course. Same subject but different disciplinary lens.
- Evidence of general education status indicates that a student may need to petition at Western
 Oregon University. Statement also could be read to understand that it would meet GE. Jared will
 follow up to clarify GE status.

Sara Henson explained that the origin of this class came from experiences with students who had anxiety and health issues related to college attendance. They are teaching it now as a HD 199 course. The new course would be a supplement to HD 100CS, more focused on healthier self-supporting habits. Agreement that this course would be helpful to nursing and culinary students. Likely not offered every term.

- HS 180 course description is not clear (course looks at intersection of infectious disease and substance addictions). Made minor revisions; Sara will review with Monica.
- Outcomes question: course objectives vs outcomes with outside focus. Michele had suggestions to make outcomes more externally-focused. Michele will send suggestions to Monica.
- Minor typo in HS 208, made in committee. Discussion of human relations explanation which was not required to be filled out; this is not required but may be added at this time.

Sara representing psychology and Matt Novak. Both of these courses have been taught as 199's a number of times.

PSY 250 came from a realization that students need to know how to read scientific journals. Not requested to be added to general education. OSU and UO have upper division courses on reading scientific literature. Made minor change to SLOs.

PSY 261 helps students prepare for Indonesia field study doing primate research. Some understanding of culture but also creation of research plan for field research project. Will likely be offered only if a student is planning on field study, so not great frequency.

6. MTH Department, Math Discipline, Jessica Giglio

MTH	MTH 261A: Introduction to Linear	
<u>261A</u>	Algebra	Added

Jessica provided background for this proposal. OSU's engineering have been using MTH 253 from COCC but need additional time with linear algebra. This course will bridge the need for engineering students. Discussion:

- Has math connected with impacted departments? Encouraged math to follow up with engineering advisors.
- Would this be taken concurrently with MTH 253 or sequentially? Either way would work.
- Recommended preparation based on OSU's practice.

Sara moved, Jenni seconded. Motion passed.
