DRAFT Charge: Task Force on Related Instruction 5/8/18

## Charge

Make a recommendation to Academic Affairs on a policy and relevant procedures for related instruction in CTE programs which provides:

- 1. Definitions/purpose statements for communication, computation, and human relations;
- 2. Alignment with state and accreditation standards, including
- 3. Assessable learning outcomes;
- 4. Criteria to guide approval decisions in Curriculum Committee.

The task force should consider the following issues:

- 1. Instructor qualifications
- 2. Minimum number of contact hours or credits in each category
- 3. Embedded vs stand-alone.
- 4. Feedback from stakeholders including COCC credit faculty.

## Background

COCC has had various approaches to related instruction in the past.

- Related instruction was approved in its current state indirectly through the Foundational Skills Task Force (approved AA for 2010-2011).
- Academic Affairs formed a task force to develop human relations criteria, which was approved for 2011-12.
- In the course of the regional accreditation review cycle over the past 16 years, NWCCU has given COCC several recommendations to better identify or address related instruction.
